Official information request for information

I refer to your official information request for information in relation to He Ara Āwhina updates. Your request was received on 27 February 2025.

Your request and our response:

[With regard to] the most recent update to the He Ara Āwhina dashboard –

Could you please provide the specific date of the last update and any relevant information regarding the latest changes or enhancements to the dashboard?

The most recently published dashboard contains information to the end of the financial year 2022/23. The data comes from a variety of organisations and was collected from these organisations via data requests during the period October 2023 – January 2024. The information sourced from the Health New Zealand | Te Whatu Ora PRIMHD dataset was extracted on 25 October 2023.

The most recently published dashboard was released to our website on 5 June 2024. This was the first update of the He Ara Āwhina dashboard. This release contained data for the 2022/23 financial year for measures that had been published in the original version, where there was data available (some of the data that we use is not updated by the source agencies every year).

As part of the June 2024 update, we made some adjustments to the set of measures used as part of the framework. You can find further information about the measures that were discontinued here:

We are currently in the process of preparing the 2025 refresh of the dashboard. This will be published in early June 2025.


